Carterton School is a decile 4 school situated in a provincial town delivering education based on the New Zealand Curriculum to Year 0 – Year 8 students.

Carterton School was opened in 1876 The school is sited near the centre of the town adjacent to Carrington Park. The roll of the school fluctuates and in the middle of the year is usually about 320 children. The school is in an outstanding setting, which includes a hall, swimming pool and generous grounds.

The school operates in four learning teams led by teachers with positions of permanent responsibility.

There is a strong Maori Heritage within the district. The parents and community members support the school by being involved in a range of school activities
